



## 33746 - Reciting Talbiyah in unison

---

### the question

Is it Sunnah for the pilgrims to recite the Talbiyah in unison, or should each person recite it on his own?.

### Detailed answer

Praise be to Allah.

Shaykh Ibn 'Uthaymeen (may Allaah have mercy on him) said:

It is not narrated that the Sahaabah (may Allaah be pleased with them) recited the Talbiyah in unison. Rather Anas ibn Maalik said: We were with the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) - meaning during the Farewell Pilgrimage - and among us were some who recited "Allaahu akbar", some who recited "Laa ilaaha ill-Allaah", and some who recited the Talbiyah. This is what is prescribed for the Muslims: for each person to recite the Talbiyah by himself, and not to pay attention to what others are reciting.

And Allaah knows best.
