5100 - Does praying Tahiyat al-Masjid mean that one does not have to pray Sunnat al-Fajr?

the question

If a person enters the mosque and prays Tahiyat al-Masjid, does that mean that he does not need to pray the two Rak'ahs of Sunnat al-Fajr? Or should he pray Tahiyat al-Masjid and then do the two Rak'ahs of Sunnat al-Fajr?

Detailed answer
