

## **7309 - Ruling on taking an interest-free loan from the bank with which his company does business**

---

### **the question**

A company has dealings with one of the banks, and this bank agrees to make interest-free loans to employees of the company, asking for a part of the employee's salary to be transferred to them in repayment. Is it permissible for the employee to take this loan from this bank?

### **Detailed answer**

We put this question to Shaykh Muhammad ibn Saalih al-'Uthaymeen, may Allaah preserve him, who answered as follows:

There is no reason why the employee should not take this loan from this bank, so long as the loan is interest-free.
