



7877 - She got married without a walee and her husband refuses to repeat the marriage contract

the question

I was married about two months after becoming Muslim and at the time I did not know much about marriage according to the Qur'an and Sunnah. So my husband (who is muslim) and I were married at a courthouse.

I have since found out that I need a wali for my marriage to be valid, and that I should be married in the correct Islamic way.

I have spoken to my husband about this and he does not want to do this. Is our marriage still valid? And if not, should I separate from him since he refuses this?

Detailed answer
